

SCAN 3000: THE MOBILE SECURITY GATE

The Canadian Air Transport Security Authority (CATSA) has placed an order for nine SCAN 3000 units for operation at Canadian airports. These vehicles are used to screen late arriving passengers on the apron area without having to transport them to a terminal for screening before they enter an aircraft. These vehicles are from CONTRAC – Cobus Industries which started to produce airport buses 21 years ago. Today more than 2600 COBUS low floor aluminium airside buses are in operation in more than 90 countries to serve more than 250 different customers in their daily operation. Since 2001 this kind of vehicle is also available for use as a mobile security check gate for airports. The unique flat floor and the load capacity of the floor construction allow the installation of various screening equipment and metal detectors inside the vehicle.



announced an order from the US Air Force (USAF), through the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia, for eight Striker 3000 and seven Striker 1500 Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting vehicles. Additionally, the USAF ordered 21 Oshkosh H-Series snow blower vehicles. The 36 trucks will be deployed at US Air Force bases throughout North America and across the globe beginning in January 2010. AIR T – CONTRACT FROM USAF

Air T has announced that its wholly owned subsidiary, Global Ground Support, LLC, has been awarded a new contract to supply deicing trucks to the United States Air Force (USAF). The contract award was for one year with four additional one-year extension options that may be exercised by the USAF. The award includes standard deicer trucks and extended-reach deicer trucks along with shipping and training costs. The actual value of the contract as well as units delivered will be determined based upon actual annual requirements of the client. The contract replaces Global's previous contract under which Global provided 420 deicers over the last 10 years.
